Please note that we strive to provide IS and OS tuition waivers (when needed) to all students. We have been able to do this successfully for every student across the past 10 years.

In addition, we work diligently to provide stipends for all students in good standing in the program. Stipends take the form of teaching assistantships, clinical training practica placements and research assistantships on faculty grants. Stipend amounts vary from year to year with the current minimum 10 month stipend set at \$16,000.
